

Privacy Policy – Family of Women

This Privacy Policy applies to all the products, services, and apps offered by the Family of Women on this website, www.FamilyofWomen.org, except where otherwise noted. We refer to those products, services, websites and apps collectively as “the website” in this policy.

This page is used to inform website visitors regarding our policies with the collection, use, and disclosure of Personal Information for anyone who decides to use the Family of Women website.

One of our main priorities is the privacy of our visitors. This Privacy Policy document contains types of information that is collected and recorded by the Family of Women and how we use it.

If you choose to use our website, then you agree to the collection and use of information in relation with this policy. The Personal Information that we collect is used for providing and improving our Service. We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

The terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions of Use, which is accessible at www.FamilyofWomen.org, unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy.

Information Collection and Use

For a better experience while using our Service, we may require you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information, including but not limited to your name, phone number, and postal address. The information that we collect will be used to contact or identify you.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

We are a Data Controller of your information.

The Family of Women’s legal basis for collecting and using the personal information described in this Privacy Policy depends on the Personal Information we collect and the specific context in which we collect the information:

- The Family of Women needs to perform a Contract with you
- You have given the Family of Women permission to do so
- Processing your personal information is in Family of Women's legitimate interests
- Family of Women needs to comply with the law

The Family of Women will retain your personal information only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your information to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our policies.

If you are a resident of the European Economic Area (EEA), you have certain data protection rights. If you wish to be informed what Personal Information we hold about you and if you want it to be removed from our systems, please contact us.

In certain circumstances, you have the following data protection rights:

- The right to access, update or to delete the information we have on you.
- The right of rectification.
- The right to object.
- The right of restriction.
- The right to data portability
- The right to withdraw consent

Log Data

We want to inform you that whenever you visit our Website, we collect information that your browser sends to us that is called Log Data. This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser version, pages of our Website that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and other statistics. These are not linked to any information that is personally identifiable. The purpose of the information is for analyzing trends, administering the site, tracking users' movement on the website, and gathering demographic information.

Cookies

Cookies are files with small amount of data commonly used as an anonymous unique identifier. These are sent to your browser from the website that you visit and are stored on your computer's hard drive.

Our website uses these "cookies" to collect information and to improve our Service. These cookies are used to store information including visitors' preferences, and the

pages on the website that the visitor accessed or visited. The information is used to optimize the users' experience by customizing our web page content based on visitors' browser type and/or other information.

You have the option to either accept or refuse these cookies and to know when a cookie is being sent to your computer. If you choose to refuse our cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Service.

Service Providers

We may employ third-party companies and individuals due to the following reasons:

- To facilitate our Website;
- To provide the services on our Website on our behalf;
- To perform Website-related services; or
- To assist us in analyzing how our Website is used.

Security
